Our Impact

Basin Burnout is built on the power of community. Every dollar we raise comes directly from the energy, passion, and generosity of the people and organizations that make our annual event possible. From the teams competing in our BBQ

Cook-Off, to the businesses sponsoring and exhibiting, to the thousands of attendees who come out each year — every contribution helps us fuel veteran-focused organizations and strengthen their ability to serve.

Since its inception, Basin Burnout has raised more than \$500,000 to distribute to veteran and community organizations through:

BBQ Competition Teams

The BBQ Cook-Off portion of the Basin Burnout is more than just a contest. Each team that registers contributes directly to Basin Burnout's fundraising efforts, turning their passion for barbecue into meaningful support for veterans. The competition draws teams from across the region, creating an atmosphere of camaraderie and spirited rivalry, all with the shared goal of giving back. Teams can also purchase additional tickets, VIP tables, and various sponsorship opportunities to increase their impact.

General Attendance

Basin Burnout is a true community event, open to the public and welcoming thousands of people from across the Permian Basin and beyond. Attendees purchase tickets to experience a full weekend of BBQ, live music, and community connection. Every ticket sold directly contributes to the total funds raised, making each guest an important part of the impact we're able to achieve for veteran organizations.

Our largest impact to date.



Thanks to our incredible supporters and partners, the 2025 Basin Burnout was our most successful event yet, with funds raised increasing by 28% compared to 2024.

In 2025, Basin Burnout reached new heights. Moving into a larger venue allowed us to welcome more people than ever before, creating space for bigger crowds, more teams, and stronger community connections. The result was our most

successful year yet - \$210,000 raised to support veteran organizations. The new venue gave us room to grow, and our community showed up in full force: 41 BBQ teams, 71 sponsors, 28 exhibitors, and a record 5,000 attendees.

Every dollar raised goes directly toward supporting veteran organizations. In 2025, that meant \$210,000 distributed across local and national nonprofits dedicated to serving those who have sacrificed for our country.
